Dear Judges:

At the pre-hearing conference session of April 14, 1982 I stated that the witness for the State of New York might not be available to present testimony on emergency planning during the week of June 22nd. The emergency drill scheduled for Shoreham has in fact been canceled so the State's emergency planning witness will be available for the week of June 22nd as well as for the week of July 6th. The emergency drill for the Fitzpatrick nuclear facility is still scheduled for July 29th and the preparation necessary for that drill makes the availability of the State witness uncertain for July 23rd and the week of July 26th.
