

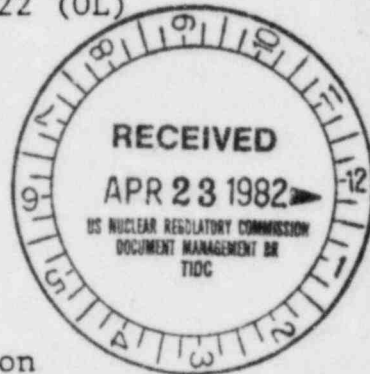

SC 16

- (1) Whether SC believes there are features of the Shoreham design that make the findings in the NRC's notice of proposed rulemaking on ATWS (46 Fed. Reg. 57521, 57522) inapplicable to Shoreham.

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
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SC 20

- (1) Whether SC believes there are features of the Shoreham design that make use of the Dresden and Limerick simulators inappropriate;
- (2) Information about any simulators that would be appropriate for use in training Shoreham operators; and
- (3) Information about how other utilities without site specific simulators select and use simulators for training operators.
