Dear Ms. Woodhead:


I am in receipt of your letter of June 7, which does not appear to correspond to my understanding of our agreements regarding answers to the disputed interrogatories by Mr. Cort of LANL.

As you will recall, Staff had agreed to answer a number of interrogatories addressed to Mr. Cort, among them interrogatories 17, 18, and 19. The requested information was not provided, and in our subsequent conversations you agreed to provide the citations from which Mr. Cort obtained the values relied upon in his study and inquired about in those interrogatories (fission product inventory, heat output after shutdown, etc.) We agreed not to require him to repeat those data in his answer if you would provide us the citations wherein those data are to be found.

Your June 4 letter only provides references to interrogatory 17. No mention is made of interrogatories 18 and 19. In addition, no page citations whatsoever are given. As I am sure you are aware, for example, the Technology of Nuclear Reactor Safety extends over two volumes and well over a thousand pages.

Because of time pressures arising from the upcoming prehearing conference, your immediate response would be appreciated.
