SUBJECT: Evaluation of Offsite Emergency Preparedness for  
the Zimmer Nuclear Power Station Exercise

Attached are reports prepared by Regions IV and V evaluating the Zimmer Nuclear Power Station exercise held on November 18, 1981.

A response from the State of Kentucky addressing deficiencies noted in the Region IV portion of the exercise is included. Region V has indicated that the State of Ohio is continuing to address the deficiencies noted in the Region V portion of the Zimmer exercise.

Region IV indicates that the State of Kentucky and involved counties are capable of implementing their offsite emergency plans even though plan and plan execution capability improvements are needed. Region V indicates that even though deficiencies were noted in both the offsite plans and the November 18, 1981 exercise, the plans are adequate to protect the public, and once corrected, will improve upon the overall offsite emergency response capability.




Dear Mr. Griffith:
