Dear Appeal Board Judges;

On 6/7/82, I submitted an Appeal Regarding the Irreversible Affect of Ammendment No. 3 to Construction Permits on the OM-OL Proceeding. As explained in the cover letter attached to the Appeal, I did not appeal the Board's April 30, 1982 Memorandum and Order earlier, because at that point the independent NRC concurrence for soils remedial work outside of the hearing was a possibility but not a reality. The NRC was to bring their integrated review to a hearing.

When the independent NRC concurrence did occur (5/25/82 letter to Cook) at about the same time that the Ammendment No. 3 was issued (5/26/82), I decided to write the appeal. The Appeal Regarding the Irreversible Affect of Ammendment No. 3 is an appeal against the Board's 4/30/82 Memorandum, since the issues of the memorandum and the ammdement are one in the same. Please extend the dates set forth at the end of April 30th Memorandum and Order in which to file an appeal, for the good cause I have mentioned.
