

SE<sub>2</sub> has learned that the officers of the Atomic Licensing Board of the NRC have agreed to a widening of the Indian Point inquiry, with inclusion of additional witnesses beyond the scope originally established by the Commission.

The Power Authority of New York has protested this development. SE<sub>2</sub> joins in the protest and suggests that the said hearings be postponed until the question before the Commission is resolved.
