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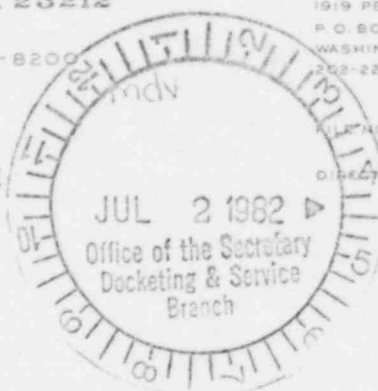



LILCO's June 25, 1982 "Response to ASLB Information Requests" was served in the same fashion as the Levy publications and the Howard qualifications.


