

Core Operating Limits Report for Cycle 4

Dear Sir:

Enclosed is a copy of Revision 2 to the Clinton Power Station (CPS) Core Operating Limits Report (COLR) for Reload 3, Operating Cycle 4. Illinois Power (IP) submitted an application for an amendment to the CPS Operating License on February 11, 1993 (Reference U-602085). The proposed amendment requested revision to Specification 3.3.1, "Reactor Protection System Instrumentation" and Bases Section 2.2.1 "Reactor Protection System Instrumentation Setpoints" for removal of the specific value of the simulated thermal power time constant (a cycle-specific parameter) to the COLR per Generic Letter 88-16. On May 25, 1993, Amendment Number 75 was issued for the CPS Operating License which permits the removal of this cycle-specific parameter from the Technical Specifications and allows it to be maintained in the COLR. The enclosed revision to the COLR accordingly reflects incorporation of this parameter.
