Gentlemen,

I have lived in the vicinity of Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant, and have since its construction began. I have experienced no problems, physical or emotional, from living in its proximity. I believe that it should be allowed to recapture the years lost between construction and startup. Particularly since they were lost through no fault of P.G. & E's. Those years were lost by regulatory changes and outside interference and should not be used to penalize P.G. & E.

I firmly believe that nuclear power is one of the answers to our energy needs. The plant has proven itself by being one of the best operating plants in the United States and will, I am sure, continue to operate in a safe and efficient manner. I believe that the current license should be extended to recapture those lost years. 
