Gentlemen:

SUBJECT: Application for Amendment of Operating License

Enclosed please find Omaha Public Power District's (OPPD) "Application for Amendment of Operating License" which seeks to amend Specification 2.7 of the Fort Calhoun Station Unit No. 1 Technical Specifications. The changes requested will enable the current configuration of the Fuel Oil System for the emergency diesel generators to meet the capacity requirements of IEEE-308 as being capable of providing fuel for 7 days of diesel generator operation following the most limiting accident. An action plan to resolve the issue of adequate on-site fuel supply was transmitted by Reference 3 in response to Reference 2. The attached proposed changes implement item number 7 of the action plan and were requested by Mr. S. D. Bloom of the NRC to facilitate NRC review of the proposed permanent solution in Reference 3.

Attachment A contains a markup reflecting the requested changes of the Technical Specifications. Attachment B provides the "Discussion, Justification and No Significant Hazards Consideration." OPPD respectfully requests 16 weeks from the date of issuance to implement these proposed changes.

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
