Gentlemen:

SUBJECT: Application for Amendment of Operating License

Enclosed please find Omaha Public Power District's (OPPD) "Application for Amendment of Operating License" which seeks to amend the Fort Calhoun Station (FCS) Unit No. 1 Technical Specifications. The proposed changes would delete Fire Protection Program elements from the FCS Technical Specifications (TS) in accordance with the provisions and guidance of Generic Letters 86-10 and 88-12 (References 2 and 3).

Attachment A contains a markup reflecting the requested changes of the TS. Attachment B provides the "Discussion, Justification and No Significant Hazards Consideration." Attachment C provides a draft copy of proposed changes to the Updated Safety Analysis Report (USAR) to indicate how the fire protection TS requirements will be incorporated into the USAR. This draft copy of proposed USAR changes is provided to assist in your review and will be reviewed and approved for incorporation after issuance of the license amendment.

OPPD respectfully requests 120 days from the date of issuance to implement these proposed changes.
