Gentlemen:

Entergy Operations, Inc. is submitting for your use and
information the Core Operating Limits Report (COLR) for Grand
Gulf Nuclear Station (GGNS). This report incorporates the
cycle specific information for GGNS Cycle 7 operation and is
submitted in accordance with Technical Specification 6.9.11.1.
The cycle-specific operating limits were removed from the
Technical Specifications (TS) via Amendment 106 to the GGNS
Unit 1 operating license (Reference 1). Attachment 1 is a
copy of the COLR.

Entergy is also submitting a revision to the current TS bases
pages developed from the Safety Evaluation performed for the
Cycle 7 reload. These pages are included as Attachment 2.
Attachment 3 is a marked-up copy of the improved TS bases
submitted on October 15, 1993 that incorporates the Cycle 7
changes. The attached current and improved TS bases are
consistent with the Cycle 7 operating limits and the analyses
performed for GGNS Cycle 7.
