Gentlemen:

Attached please find revised pages 3/4 4-1 and 3/4 4-3 to replace pages 3/4 4-1 and 3/4 4-3 of the proposed defueled technical specifications previously forwarded to the Commission by SNRC-1752 (reference 1).


Subsequent review of the APPLICABILITY statements for proposed technical specifications 3.4.1.1 and 3.4.2.1 as submitted in the reference (1) letter, has resulted in further revision to avoid potential confusion. Specifically, the 2nd sentence in footnote "#" of each respective technical specification should be deleted. The intent of footnote "#" in technical specifications 3.4.1.1 and 3.4.2.1 is to permit the use of commercial grade replacement parts in the onsite A.C. and D.C. power distribution systems and in the TDI Diesel Generators, including their support systems. Although these systems and components have been designed, built, tested, operated, and maintained as "safety-related," they will no longer perform safety-related functions under a Defueled Facility Operating License. LILCO has determined that the sentence deletion (see attachments) will not detract from the intent of the footnote or affect the associated BASES of the proposed technical specifications for Shoreham in the defueled condition.
