**SUBJECT: NRC CONSENT TO INDIRECT CHANGE OF CONTROL ZEVACOR
MOLECULAR, NRC LICENSE NOS. 13-35179-02 AND 13-35179-03**

Dear Mr. Trusner

By letter dated December 20, 2019, Zevacor Molecular (you, Zevacor) submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Region III Office a Request for Consent to an indirect License Change of Control of NRC Materials License Nos. 13-35179-02 and 13-35179-03. Your letter is available electronically from NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) at accession number ML19357A266. ADAMS is accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>.

Based on the information provided, we understand that as a result of a proposed asset transfer from Zevacor's parent company – Illinois Health and Science (IHS) – to Curium US PET LLC (Curium US PET), a future subsidiary of Curium US Holdings LLC (Curium), control of Zevacor would be indirectly transferred to Curium US PET. Based on the information provided in your initial letter and in your subsequent letter dated February 24, 2020, we further understand that this transfer will not result in any change to the licensed materials, persons using the licensed material, location of use of licensed material, or persons responsible for the licensee's radiation safety program. The February 24, 2020 letter may be found in ADAMS at accession number ML20056C981.

Based on the above understandings and as more fully detailed in the enclosed NRC staff's Safety Evaluation Report (SER), which documents the NRC staff's review of the request, we have no objection to the proposed transfer. Based on information provided in your initial letter, we understand that, on or about February 28, 2020, the licensee intends that all of Zevacor's assets would be transferred to Curium US PET.

Please note that you will need to notify us promptly, in writing, after the transaction has been finalized, and include a signed copy documentation of the proposed asset transfer agreement confirming completion of the transaction. With this information, we can issue an administrative amendment to your NRC license to reflect the transaction, if necessary. If this planned asset transfer has not been consummated by March 31, 2020, please notify us in writing.


