
Intervenor submits the following two affidavits pursuant to the Board's order:


1. Richard L. Reiter's Affidavit: Mr. Reiter originally requested confidentiality but now no longer believes such confidentiality is required.

2. Affidavit concerning July 8, 1982 CG&E and Kaiser Management Policy Meeting. Intervenor will submit within a week a lengthy affidavit from this affiant which provides greater detail about his experiences as an engineer at Zimmer.

One former Zimmer worker who gave Intervenor's counsel an affidavit in confidence cannot be contacted at the present time to obtain his consent to submit his affidavit under a protective order to this Board. As soon as MVPP can contact him MVPP will submit his affidavit to the Board. Another former Zimmer worker has completed an affidavit but has not yet mailed it to Intervenor because he recently moved to accept new employment. Upon receipt of his affidavit, MVPP will submit it to the Board.
