Amendment No. 5 further amends GESSAR II by:

1. Furnishing the additional information requested in the Commission's GESSAR II acceptance review letter dated December 9, 1981, pertaining to environmental qualification of safety-related equipment (Questions 270.1, 270.2, 270.3, and 270.4 of Enclosure 1 and Item 1 of Enclosure 2 to acceptance review letter).
2. Providing answers to 3 additional geotechnical questions contained in the acceptance review letter (Questions 271.22, 271.25 and 271.26 of Enclosure 1).
3. Requiring the applicant to provide Chapter 15 Technical Specifications.
4. Clarifying portions of the text where obvious discrepancies exist.


