In accordance with 10 CFR Part 50.59, we are enclosing 40 copies of a requested amendment to the operating licenses DPR-77 and DPR-79 for a change to the Sequoyah Nuclear Plant units 1 and 2 technical specifications (Enclosure 1). The proposed amendment requests a change in Table 4.3-9 to incorporate downscale failure alarms and a change in the surveillance requirements for ice condenser doors. The justifications to support the proposed changes are provided in Enclosure 2.

In accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR Part 170.22, we have determined the proposed amendment to be Class II for unit 1 and Class I for unit 2. This classification is based on the fact that the amendment is an administrative change and involves a second essentially identical unit at the same site. The remittance of \$1,600 is being wired to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Attention: Licensing Fee Management Branch.
