
We hereby request this amendment to be made effective 30 days after issuance to allow adequate time for implementation. No new commitments are made in this letter.


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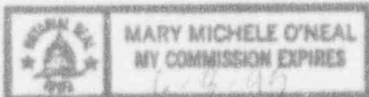

EVALUATION OF CHANGE WITH RESPECT TO 10 CFR 50.92Background:

The Iowa Electric Light and Power (IELP) Licensing Department recently compared the IELP controlled copy of Duane Arnold Energy Center (DAEC) Technical Specifications (TS) with the NRC authority file copy. This comparison was initiated after some discrepancies were identified.

Upon completion of this comparison, IELP Licensing discussed all the discrepancies with NRC to develop a plan for resolving them. One part of that plan was for IELP to request TS revisions to correct the administrative and typographical errors identified. This TS amendment request is submitted to correct those errors.

Date of Amendment Request: December 22, 1993

Description of Amendment Request:

The proposed TS Amendment consists of changes which should have been included as part of previous amendment requests, capitalizing a defined word, spelling corrections, correcting typographical errors and revisions to make TS consistent with other approved documents. All the changes are editorial in nature.

Basis for proposed no significant hazards consideration:

The Commission has provided standards (10 CFR 50.92(c)) for determining whether a significant hazards consideration exists. A proposed amendment to an operating license for a facility involves no significant hazards consideration if operation of the facility in accordance with the proposed amendment would not (1) involve a significant increase in the probability or consequences of an accident previously evaluated; (2) create the possibility of a new or different kind of accident from any accident previously evaluated; or (3) involve a significant reduction in a margin of safety.

In reviewing this proposed amendment to the DAEC TS, we have reached these conclusions:

- 1) The proposed amendment does not involve a significant increase in the probability or consequences of an accident previously evaluated. The amendment would only correct administrative and typographical errors. No physical changes to the plant or to the operation of the plant would result from this amendment.

- 2) The proposed amendment will not create the possibility of a new or different kind of accident from any evaluated previously. The amendment would only correct administrative and typographical errors. No physical changes to the plant or to operation of the plant would result from this amendment.
- 3) The proposed amendment will not reduce the margin of safety. The amendment would only correct administrative and typographical errors. No physical changes to the plant or to operation of the plant would result from this amendment.

Based upon the above, we have determined that the proposed Amendment will not involve a significant hazards consideration.

3.5-6	Delete reference to 3.5.D.3 from Section 3.5.D.1 to be consistent with revisions to Section 3.5.D per Amendment 174.
3.6-33	Revise reference to FSAR Section 7.3.1.1.24 to 7.3.1.1.2.4 to correct a typographical error.
3.7-31	Correct spelling of "coolant" in the third sentence of the first paragraph.
6.8-2	Change the word "Plan" to "Program" in Section 6.8.1.15 to be consistent with TS 6.15.
6.11-4	Revise reference to 4.7.A.2.f to be 4.7.A.2.g in Section 6.11.3.d. This reference was omitted when the Sections were renumbered as part of Amendment 100.
6.11-5	Revise reference to 7.3.2.2 to be 6.3.2.1 in Section 6.11.3.j. Also in 6.11.3.1, change "exceeds" to "is equal to or greater than". Both changes will make TS consistent with the Offsite Dose Assessment Manual (ODAM).
