Definitions:

Control: Control of a license is in the hands of the person or persons who are empowered to decide when and how that license will be used. That control is to be found in the person or persons who, because of ownership or authority explicitly delegated by the owners, possess the power to determine corporate policy and, thus, the direction of the activities under the license.

Transferee: A transferee is an entity that proposes to purchase or otherwise gain control of an NRC-licensed operation.

Transferor: A transferor is an NRC licensee selling or otherwise giving up control of a licensed operation.

Response: The general partnership ownership interests of Masa Fujioka & Associates (MFA), the "Licensee", has changed as a result of a purchase agreement, whereby Midori SQRT, LLC and Sakura SQRT, LLC, both Hawaii limited liability companies, acquired the Licensee from sellers, Masanobu R. Fujioka and Sueng-Hee Fujioka. The Licensee name, physical location, mailing address, and contact information, including phone numbers, remains unchanged. NRC contact and MFA's Radiation Safety Officer, Jayson Mitsuyoshi, whom has been the designated RSO since 2008, also remains unchanged. In addition, Masanobu R. Fujioka remains an employee at MFA. The new ownership began on January 1, 2019.

2. Describe any changes in personnel or duties that relate to the licensed program. Include training and experience for new personnel and any changes in the training program.

Response: MFA does not anticipate any changes in personnel related to the licensed

program. NRC contact and MFA's Radiation Safety Officer, Jayson Mitsuyoshi, whom has been the designated RSO since 2008, will continue to be the RSO named in the materials license. Mr. Mitsuyoshi's responsibilities in administering and managing the Radiation Safety Program, including its training program, will continue after the change in ownership.

3. Describe any changes in the location, facilities, equipment, radiation safety program, use, possession, waste management, or other procedures that relate to the licensed program.

Response: MFA does not anticipate any changes to its physical location, facilities, equipment, radiation safety program, use, possession, or operating procedures that relate to the licensed program.

4. Describe the status of the licensee's facilities, equipment, and radiation safety program, including any known contamination and whether decontamination will occur prior to transfer. Include the status of calibrations, leak tests, area surveys, wipe tests, training, quality control, and related records.

Response: MFA does not anticipate any changes to its facilities, equipment, and radiation safety program that relate to the licensed program. All historical and current records pertaining to facilities, equipment and the radiation safety program will remain at the physical location after the change of ownership. MFA currently owns and operates four (4) CPN nuclear gauges in its inventory. The nuclear gauges will continue to be stored at the physical location, or at temporary job sites, as necessary on a case-by-case basis. The radiation alert survey meter was last calibrated by S.E. International, Inc. in June 2019. CPN International – InstroTek leak tested all four (4) of MFA's CPN nuclear gauges in October 2018. MFA's RSO has trained all current personnel who may use nuclear gauges at temporary job sites. MFA's RSO recently completed IATA Dangerous Goods Training in May 2019.

5. If current decommissioning funding plans (DFP) will be changed as a result of the transfer, the revised DFP should be submitted. If other financial assurance documents will be changed as a result of the transfer, confirm that all financial assurance instruments associated with the license will be held in the transferee's name before the license is transferred, and as required by 10 CFR 30.35(f), the licensee must, within 30 days, submit financial instruments reflecting such changes.

Response: N/A, MFA does not plan to engage in decommissioning activities as a result of the change of ownership.

6. Confirm that all records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the facility will be transferred to the transferee or to NRC, as appropriate. These records include documentation of surveys of ambient radiation levels and fixed and/or removable contamination, including methods and sensitivity.

Response: N/A, MFA does not plan to engage in decommissioning activities as a result of the change of ownership.

7. Confirm that both transferor and transferee agree to transferring control of the licensed material and activity, and the conditions of transfer, and that the transferee has been

made aware of any open inspection items and its responsibility for possible resulting enforcement actions.

Response: Masanobu R. Fujioka and Sueng-Hee Fujioka (Transferor) are in agreement to transfer control of the licensed material and activity to Midori SQRT, LLC and Sakura SQRT, LLC (Transferee). The Transferee has been made aware of any open inspection items and its responsibility for possible resulting enforcement actions.

8. Confirm that the transferee will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments of the transferor or that the transferee will submit a complete description of the proposed licensed program.

Response: Midori SQRT, LLC and Sakura SQRT, LLC (Transferee) will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments of the transferor.


