It has come to our attention that Amendment No. 27 to your NRC Material License No. 21-26539-01 and the Safety Evaluation Report (SER), both dated October 22, 2019, contained errors.

Enclosed are corrected copies of these documents.

The corrected copy of Amendment No. 27 shows the removal of unnecessary punctuation after the word "Road" that appeared in Subitem No. 2. Also, Condition No. 16.F. showed an accession number of "ML19108438," which is wrong. This has been corrected to "ML19108A438."

In the SER, the incorrect accession number of "ML19108438" appeared twice. It has now been corrected to "ML19108A438."

In the SER, under "Safety and Security Review," the second from last paragraph, the original SER stated that "Dr. Marshall has been an authorized user.....," which is incorrect. The SER has been corrected to show that "Dr. Bailey has been an authorized user.....," which is correct.

We apologize for these errors and for any inconvenience they may have caused you.


