Dear Mr. Denton:

As counsel for Omaha Public Power District, we hereby submit three (3) signed originals and nineteen (19) copies of a document entitled "Application for Amendment of Operating License", together with forty (40) copies of the proposed Technical Specifications. The application seeks to amend Part 3.A. of Page 4 of Facility Operating License No. DPR-40 to allow operation of the Fort Calhoun Station at a nominal reactor core power level of 1500 megawatts thermal, where this power level is defined to be a 24 hour average power level.

The proposed Amendment is deemed to be a Class III Amendment within the meaning of Section 170.22 of the regulations of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission. Accordingly, a check for the appropriate fee of \$4,000 is also enclosed.
