Documents related to License R-78, KU Training Reactor:

Radioactive Waste Burial Log; Records of External Radiation Exposure, Air/Water Sampling Data Sheets; and Records of Visitor Exposure Monitoring- for FY 1978-79, 79-80, 80-81, 81-82.

Minutes of the May 5th, 1982, meeting of the University of Kansas' Nuclear Reactor Committee. The committee discussed the KU reactor which had been inoperable during the first part of this year due to transients causing spurious scram signals on channels A and B.

Documents related to the university's license to receive, use, and dispose of radioisotopes:

Records of radioisotope shipments received, and if applicable, disposed of, for FY 1979-80, 80-81, 81-82.

The Committee for Radiation Safety would also like to be provided with a list of sites on campus where radioisotope-related research

wastes, such as trinitium and carbon 14, are being stored. The university has not been using its state-licensed radioactive waste burial site since hazardous waste regulations were implemented by the Environmental Protection Agency in the Spring of 1980.
