

QUALITY ASSURANCE AUDIT OF TMI RELATED COMMITMENTS

Dear Mr. O'Reilly:

As identified in I&E Inspection Report 50-324/82-36 and 50-325/82-33, Carolina Power & Light Company committed to perform a quality assurance audit of the TMI related commitments at the Brunswick station by December 31, 1982 (IFI 82-33-01). CP&L hereby revises that commitment to April 30, 1983.

Manpower requirements to support the outages and the Brunswick Improvement Plan have prevented the Quality Assurance group from completing the audit by its commitment date. Portions of the audit have been completed as documented in surveillance QASR-82-12. To provide manpower to complete the audit, CP&L plans to hire a qualified contractor to complete the audit. This revised date will allow ample time to select the contractor and for the contractor to perform the in-depth audit that will be required.
