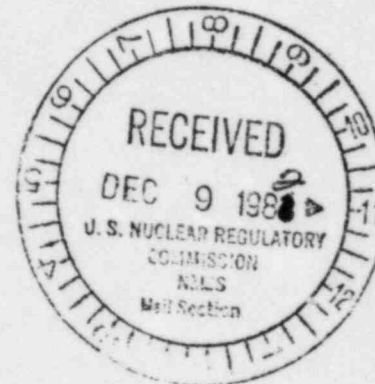

Dear Mr. Sherr:

The Nebraska Public Power District is preparing to ship irradiated reactor fuel from Nebraska Public Power District, Cooper Nuclear Station, Brownville, Nebraska, on Nebraska Public Power District's License Number DPR-46 to the General Electric Storage Facility at Morris, Illinois, License Number SNM 2500, NRC Docket No. 72-1. The proposed shipment consists of irradiated boiling water reactor fuel assemblies. As licensee and shipper of the irradiated nuclear fuel, and in accordance with Title 10 CFR Part 73.37, we are herein submitting for approval the route of travel for the material described in Enclosure 1.

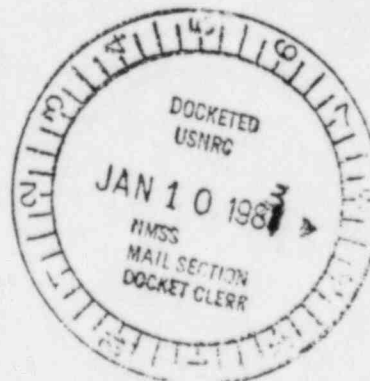
