IE Bulletin 82-04, "Deficiencies in Primary Containment Electrical Penetrations," identified problems associated with penetration assemblies manufactured by Bunker Ramo Company. We have conducted a review and conclude there are no Bunker Ramo electrical penetration assemblies installed or planned for installation at Beaver Valley Unit No. 1.

Our estimate of the manpower expended in conducting reviews required by this Bulletin, its associated Information Notice IE 82-40, and in preparation of this response is 70 manhours. Since no corrective action will be required as a result of this Bulletin, no manpower will be required for corrective action.
