

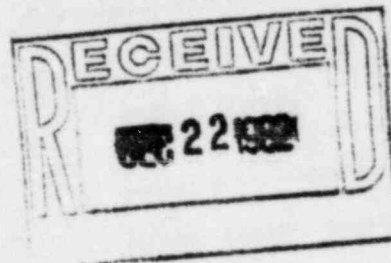

Distribution of Emergency Instructions
to Transient Population

Gentlemen:

This letter is to document the telephone conversation held between NRC's Mr. Charles Hackney and AP&L's Mr. Ted Enos and Mr. Dale James on November 4, 1982, concerning the distribution of emergency information to the transient population of the ANO EPZ.

AP&L considers the transient population for emergency planning purposes to be made up of two separate groups, those individuals who are visitors to the area, (who have come to use the parks and lakes), and new residents of the EPZ.

To provide information to the visitors, AP&L proposes to make available emergency instruction pamphlets like the enclosed to Hotels, Motels, and to State and Federal parks in the 10 mile EPZ. AP&L believes that by placing emergency instructions in these locations that the majority of the visitors to the area will have access to the information.

To provide emergency instructions to new residents, AP&L proposes to make available informational material at banks, savings & loans, select public buildings (those that would likely be visited by new residents), hospitals and utility business offices. AP&L considers these likely locations to be visited by new residents.



This distribution program will be implemented by the Arkansas Nuclear Planning and Response Program (ANP&RP is an office of the Arkansas Department of Health). A listing of the specific locations where emergency instruction will be available, coordinated, and maintained by the ANP & RP office.

Emergency instructions are currently available to the transient population through the distribution of emergency instruction pamphlets by the ANP & RP office to hotels, motels, and parks, and through instructions found in the local telephone directory. AP&L believes this program has and continues to meet the intent of 10CFR50 Appendix E; however, the above described program is being implemented to more thoroughly document dissemination of emergency instructions.

This program will be implemented as described within the next 90 days. If the NRC has any comments on the above described program, please submit them within the next 30 days such that corrective action can be taken.
