- Radiation monitoring before and after the plant opens
- Warning of the Public
- Emergency planning for protection of the Public
- Emergency planning implementation (Public protection)
- Emergency planning exercises (assure public protection)
- Public evacuation insurance coverage (all eventualities)
- Estimated time for contamination to reach Rye after accident

Further, we wish to be allowed to address any other subjects on which interested municipalities are entitled to comment.
