Attached are six copies (Copies 10-14 & 16) of Revision 3 to the River Bend Station Training and Qualification Plan. Proprietary Information status if requested for this information pursuant to 10CFR2.790(d).

This revision is necessitated by changes in proposed operating procedures and organizational changes as a result of the further refinement of the security program at River Bend Station by Gulf States Utilities Company. A summary of the major changes is as follows:


1. Time references in the Tasks have been deleted throughout, because they are not considered crucial to the performance of the Task, and are incapable of exact definition at this point in time.
2. References to specific numbers of persons to be processed through the access control system have been deleted because they are not considered crucial to Task performance.
3. Task 17 has been renumbered as Task 7 for consistency and the remaining tasks have been renumbered.
4. Former Tasks 25 and 33 have been deleted as they are redundant to Tasks 21 through 24 and Tasks 1 and 39, respectively.
5. Task titles for Task 1 and 31 have been revised for clarification.
6. Editorial changes have been made throughout.
7. The Task and Duty Summary has been revised to reflect changes in the organizational structure and to clarify responsibilities for various tasks.

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8. The Task Identification Summary has been revised to reflect the latest revisions to the River Bend Physical Security Plan.
9. The Task Identification Summary and Task and Duty Summary have been revised to reflect new Task numbers and titles.
10. Section 1.1 has been revised to reflect that the minimum age of 18 is a requirement for assignment to the Security Force in an unarmed capacity.


