Dear Mr. Saltzman:

On November 10, 1982 we forwarded to the Commission Philadelphia Electric Company's check #N2079678 dated November 3, 1982 in the amount of \$19,758.00 in payment of the indemnity fee for DPR-44 for Peach Bottom Unit 2 for the period November 17, 1982 to November 16, 1983. On the same day we forwarded the Company's check #2079677 dated November 3, 1982 in the amount of \$19,758.00 in payment of the indemnity fee for DPR-56 for Peach Bottom Unit 3 for the period November 1, 1982 to October 31, 1983.

As of November 15, 1982 the annual indemnity fee applicable to Peach Bottom Units 2 and 3 was reduced from \$6.00 per thermal megawatt to \$1,000 per reactor. Accordingly, it is hereby


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Mr. Jerome Saltzman
