

REQUEST FOR MODIFICATIONS TO SPECIAL CONDITION 1
NORTH ANNA NPDES PERMIT NO. VA00052451

Dear Mr. Kregloe:

This letter is to confirm your February 17, 1981 telephone conversation with Mr. M. F. Kadlubowski of this Department and to formalize our request for the subject modifications discussed during that conversation.

Special Condition 1, as it is currently worded, calls for estimating "the number of eggs, larvae and plankton entrained". We believe that this wording is somewhat vague and repetitive and we propose that it be reworded to "the numbers of fish eggs and larvae entrained".

The second change requested is a modification of the last sentence of the condition which requires that both impingement and entrainment reports be submitted on a quarterly basis. We request that this be changed to "impingement reports will be submitted on a quarterly basis within 90 days of the end of the quarter. Entrainment reports will be submitted in the third quarter report as the collection period extends from March through July". Both of these changes are requested on the basis of practicality.

Your prompt consideration of these proposed modifications will be greatly appreciated and if we can provide any additional information, please contact us.
