Gentlemen:

By letter dated July 14, 1982 we were notified by your office that we had failed to remit the sum of \$4,000 pursuant to 10 CFR 170.22 with our application for Amendment to Facility Operating License No. DPR-66.

This letter is to advise you that Amendment 52 was a revision to Amendment 51 which had been recently issued and was part of our original submittal on the Rod Position Indication System. Amendments 51 and 52 are part of the continuing review on this single safety issue, which remains open at this time. Duquesne Light met with the NRC on July 13 to discuss the technical details of the amendment and the Rod Position Indication System functional requirements and developed a schedule for resolution of this issue.

Duquesne Light had prior agreement with the reviewing group for maintaining this issue open pending final disposition of this item. Since this issue is still unresolved, and is part of the original safety issue review effort, we believe that no Class III fee is due.

This issue may be referred to our License Project Manager, Mr. Peter Tam, if further clarification is necessary.
