Report for Period of January 1, 1994 - June 30, 1994

POSITIVE TEST RESULTS

Random

No Wolf Creek Nuclear Operating personnel tested positive for drugs or alcohol during this time period.

Pre-Access

Three contractors tested positive during the period and were denied access. One contractor tested positive for marijuana and amphetamine, another for marijuana, and a third for amphetamines and methamphetamines.

For Cause

There were no "for cause" tests performed.

Fitness for Duty Program Changes

The random pool was adjusted January 1, 1994, to fifty percent of the Wolf Creek Nuclear Operation Corporation population.

A new Medical Review Officer (MRO) service was chosen. The new service is located fifteen miles from the plant.

The Continuous Observation Program was improved to detect personnel away from the observation program for more than 30 days through an electronic system. Personnel away from observation for more than 30 days will be denied access until they have tested negative for drugs and alcohol, and completed a questionnaire regarding their activities during their absence.

Events Reported in Accordance With 10 CFR 26.73

No events occurred during this reporting period requiring reporting in accordance with 10 CFR 26.73.
