Dear Mr. Harrison:

In response to your letter of April 22, 1983 regarding ANI activity at the Zimmer site, Moscow, Ohio we offer the following:

1. Presently, there is no ASME Code work in process at the Zimmer Site due to a stop work order by the NRC, which could account for the ANIs spending more time in the office than usual doing documentation reviews.

H. J. Kaiser is continuing to resolve existing nonconformities and verification of resolutions, in many instances, the ANIs do visit other areas on site e.g. reactor building, receiving area, weld test area, etc. to perform their verification activities.

2. The procedure that has been established by H. J. Kaiser is that they contact the ANIs at the office. H. J. Kaiser personnel bring traveler packages, nonconformance reports, and all other ASME Code inspection related documents to the office for ANI's review and acceptance. Travelers are reviewed and hold points established. When as a result of reviews of documentation, inspection and verification is required and the ANIs do go to the area required to verify the resolution.
3. Hartford Steam Boiler personnel are instructed to attend every meeting they are invited to by Hartford's clients. However, it is a policy of Hartford Steam Boiler not to attend meetings to which we are not invited.

We informed H. J. Kaiser that since we are they're Authorized Inspection Agency and have an Inspection Agreement with them, that invitations to site meetings shall be through H. J. Kaiser. When our presence is requested, an H. J. Kaiser employee shall also be present.
