

NRC recently approved our proposed changes to the Sequoyah unit 1 and unit 2 technical specifications (T/S) to reflect the forthcoming installation of undervoltage protection for Class 1E buses. This approval was received on May 5, 1983 by Amendment 29 to Facility Operating License DPR-77 for unit 1 and by Amendment 18 to Facility Operating License DPR-79 for unit 2. In a May 24, 1983 telephone conversation with Carl Stahle of your staff, we discussed the intent of implementation of the T/S changes. Accordingly, we plan to implement the T/S changes upon completion of the undervoltage modifications, which could occur before shutdown of unit 2 for the forthcoming refueling outage.


