1. Three (3) originals and thirty-seven (37) copies of an Application for an Amendment to the Operating License to amend Appendix A of our license to reduce to fifty percent (50%) the number of incore moveable detector thimbles required for the system to be operable.

2. Forty (40) copies of documents designated Attachments A and B which set forth the requested change in Technical Specification and its safety evaluation.

Supporting documentation for this proposed change is contained in a Thimble Deletion Study performed by Westinghouse Electric Corporation and will be submitted at a later date.

We have determined this to be a Class III change request, and a check for \$4,000.00 will be submitted under separate cover in accordance with 10 CFR 170.22.
