
Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 2
Withdrawal of License Amendment Request for
One-Time Extension to 18-Month Snubber Surveillance

In a letter dated July 26, 1994,⁽¹⁾ Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) proposed a license amendment change to DPR-65 for Millstone Unit No. 2. The proposed change requested an approximate two month one-time extension to the snubber surveillance interval. On July 27, 1994, Millstone Unit No. 2 was removed from service for 'A' reactor coolant pump maintenance. During this approximate two week outage, NNECO intends to perform the 18-month snubber surveillance for which the extension had been proposed. Therefore, we hereby withdraw our proposed license amendment request.
