
Dear Sirs:

The Mapleton Interveners sometime ago, requested that our Technical Director, Steve J. Gadler of St. Paul, obtain information concerning the dewatering systems at the Midland Plant. In this respect, information was specifically requested concerning the total number of wells and the amount of electricity that will be required to be utilized in the operation of those wells for the dewatering purposes. This letter, dated the 11th of March, 1983, has not been answered, and it seems that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission are dragging their feet in this respect.

From Revision #14 Volume 1, Consumers Power Company to NRC's request regarding plant fill, we find a total of 96 wells that have been drilled, but the sizes in some instances are indeterminate.

The Mapleton Interveners would appreciate this information so that it can continue with its analysis of the capability of the wells to dewater the plant area.
