Dear Mr. Denton:

Duke Power Company hereby requests an exemption to 10 CFR 50.71(e) which requires each holder of an operating license for a nuclear power reactor to update their Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR) initially within 24 months of either July 22, 1980 or the date of issuance of the operating license, whichever is later.

In my letter to you dated October 25, 1982, Duke Power Company explained its position on the above mentioned regulation. It is now Duke Power Company's intent to submit an updated FSAR twelve months after the issue date of the McGuire Unit 2 operating license. Please advise us if there are any questions regarding this exemption request.

This change is considered to be a Class II license amendment pursuant to 10 CFR 170.22. Therefore, a check in the amount of \$1,200 is enclosed.
