Counsel will also be meeting separately to discuss the PPA-related contentions, including possible elimination or modification of particular contentions.

Applicant therefore requests that it be permitted until Friday, June 10, 1983 to deliver its response in hand to the Licensing Board.^{2/} This will give it the opportunity to report to the Board regarding any agreements reached among the parties and to focus its presentation on the remaining issues.

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
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
