Self-Initiated Audit

Gentlemen:

The Institute of Nuclear Power Operations (INPO), in response to concerns raised by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Chairman Palladino, has developed criteria which will be used by utilities in performing self-initiated audits of their engineering and construction programs. The Cincinnati Gas & Electric Company has had representatives at various INPO meetings when plans were being formulated to do the self-initiated audits. It was envisioned that all utilities with construction less than 80% completed would conduct self-initiated audits.

Since the Wm. H. Zimmer Nuclear Power Station is over 90% completed, we do not plan to conduct a self-initiated audit. As a result of the NRC immediate action letter dated April of 1981, Cincinnati Gas & Electric Company has had double inspection on all essential work. In addition to the double inspection, we plan to conduct various in-house audits similar to the audits proposed by INPO.
