Texas Utilities Generating Company is submitting the Comanche Peak Steam Electric Station Licensed Operator Requalification Training Program description (CPSES Training Procedure, TRA-204), attached for NRC approval per 10CFR55, Appendix A.

Those who review this procedure for approval will note that its language does not exactly correspond to the CPSES/FSAR Section 13.2. Our FSAR is soon to be amended to agree with the language of this procedure.

CPSES cold license examinations are scheduled to begin July 19, 1983. We understand that operators enrolled in an approved requalification program will not be subject to cold license reexamination, should our fuel load schedule slip. We intend to enroll our operators in this program after licensing examination results are known. In order to facilitate a smooth transition from the examination to the training program, we would appreciate your approval of our program by September 19, 1983.
