Dear Mr. Novak:

Enclosed are three signed originals and sixty copies of Amendment No. 30 to the Waterford 3 FSAR.

This amendment consists of an update to FSAR Section 9.5.1 (Fire Protection System), Appendix 9.5B (Fire Damper Analysis), and incorporation of the Safe Shutdown Analysis into the FSAR as Appendix 9.5A, as well as revisions to Chapter 13 and other miscellaneous FSAR updates.

The fire protection system revision mentioned above consists primarily of the following:

- (1) Incorporation of the Safe Shutdown Analysis, previously submitted to the NRC as an attachment to reference 1, as FSAR Appendix 9.5A.
- (2) Incorporation of our responses to Auxiliary Systems Branch supplemental fire protection questions, previously submitted to the NRC as reference 2, into the SSA.
- (3) An update of Section 9.5.1 to ensure consistency with the Fire Damper Analysis and the Safe Shutdown Analysis.

The fire protection revisions are primarily therefore an incorporation of existing and previously submitted information into an FSAR format. The final step in this process will be a revision to Part VIII of the Fire

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

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Protection Program Re-Evaluation. This is known as the Fire Hazards Analysis, and is a Fire Area by Fire Area discussion of combustible loadings, Fire Control Features and barriers, Analyses of Postulated Fires, etc. Part VIII will be amended in March 1983 to reflect the additional commitments made during the course of the NRC review.
