

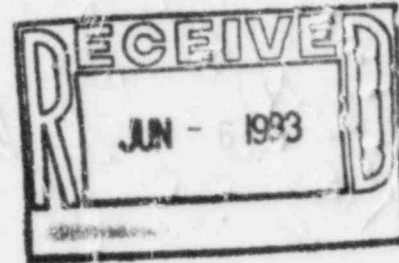


Dear Mr. Seidle:

This letter provides an interim report on a potential 10CFR50.55(e) item concerning workmanship on Swagelok Fittings at the Wolf Creek jobsite. This item was initially reported on February 15, 1983, with supplemental information provided in the Reference.

The information obtained from inspections and testing of various tubing installations has been transmitted to the Architect/Engineer (A/E) for evaluation of this concern. Upon receipt of the A/E's report, Kansas Gas and Electric Company will make a final evaluation of the safety implications of this matter and determine whether or not any additional corrective action is required.

A final or interim report on this subject will be submitted to you on or before August 8, 1983. In the interim, please direct any questions concerning this matter to me or to Mr. Otto Maynard of my staff.
