Dear Sir,

As a resident of Long Island, I am writing to you to express my concern regarding the utility-sponsored emergency (evacuation) plan recently submitted to the NRC by Lico.

Since the major issue here will be whether or not the NRC will ignore the language of its own regulations and allow an emergency plan by a private utility to substitute for that of a duly elected government, I feel that it is important that the Commission itself (not the licensing board) be the deciding entity. This seems even more imperative in light of the fact that there is now an entirely new licensing board. - Three men previously unfamiliar with the Shoreham case - appointed to hear the emergency planning litigation.

On behalf of my family, my neighbors and my community, I ask that you please present this major issue to the full Commission. I cannot stress enough how disillusioned this county is becoming in view of the fact that since Lico cannot legally put Shoreham on line under the existing NRC law, the utility may have enough influence to see the law changed in order to do so.
