Response to IE Bulletin 82-04

Gentlemen:

IE Bulletin 82-04 deals with deficiencies in Bunker Ramo primary containment electrical penetration assemblies. We have determined that no Bunker Ramo assemblies are installed at ANO-1, however, Bunker Ramo assemblies are installed at ANO-2. This letter documents the results of the work performed as a result of IE Bulletin 82-04.

Action Item 1 requires the inspection of non-installed spare Bunker Ramo units. The required inspection was performed per Items 1a, 1b, and 1c and no defects were noted.

Action Item 2 does not apply to ANO. Action Item 3 requests a review of past operational and related maintenance records of these electrical penetration units for circuit functionality problems similar to those discussed in the Bulletin. A review of Job Orders, LEs and Maintenance History was performed. No items were identified that related to the failure noted in the Bulletin.

Action Item 4 deals with repairs to units identified as unacceptable under the provisions of Items 1, 2, and 3. No penetrations were identified as unacceptable under those Items, therefore no repairs are necessary.

Action Item 5 requires a report describing the results of the inspections discussed in Item 3b and addressed by the plan described in the report discussed in 5b(3). Since no further actions are required per Items 3a and 3b and no repairs are necessary per Item 4 no report will be necessary pursuant to the requirements of Item 6.






