SEQUOYAH NUCLEAR PLANT UNITS 1 AND 2 - NRC-OIE REGION II INSPECTION REPORT

The subject OIE inspection report dated August 20, 1982 from R. C. Lewis to H. G. Parris cited TVA with two Severity Level IV Violations. The final response to each item of violation in the inspection report was submitted by my September 21, 1982 letter to you.


As discussed with Linda Watson of your staff in a telephone conversation on February 15, 1983, TVA did not achieve full compliance on January 30, 1983 as expected and as stated in the response to Item A of Appendix A to the subject inspection report. Issuance of the procedure to establish the corrective action escalation program is expected to be completed on or before February 18, 1983. Therefore, TVA expects to be in full compliance on or before February 25, 1983.
