IE Bulletin 83-01

We have reviewed IE Bulletin 83-01 [Failure of Reactor Trip Breakers (Westinghouse DB-50) to Open on Automatic Trip Signal] and have completed the actions requested as follows:

- a) A surveillance test of the undervoltage trip function, independent of the shunt trip, was performed on February 26, 1983 in accordance with plant operating procedure 1004.2, Reactor Protection System - Periodic Test. Proper operation of the reactor trip breakers was demonstrated.
- b) Maintenance Procedure 0707.10, Reactor Trip and Generator Output Breakers - Inspection and Maintenance, was reviewed to verify compliance with the recommendations of Westinghouse NSD Data Letter 74-2.

Although no frequency is specified in this procedure, it has always been performed during refueling shutdown. A procedure change is being made to require a refueling maintenance interval.

MP 0707.10 conforms to all the other guidelines of Westinghouse NSD Data Letter 74-2.

- c) A notice has been prepared to make all licensed operators aware of the recent Salem 1 event and call attention to plant procedures which give direction in case such an event should occur at Turkey Point. This notice has been distributed to all on-shift operators as they arrive. Off-shift operators are receiving notification through the plant mail.

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




