Subject: Modification to NRC Commitment

Reference 4 page 6 committed Detroit Edison to performing a joint field walkdown of all field modifications with representatives of Engineering, Operations, and the implementing organization. During the current refueling outage, it became apparent that strict adherence to this commitment may cause individuals to receive unnecessary radiation dose. Radiation dose can be reduced to plant personnel if the requirement for the implementing organization to participate in the joint walkdown is removed. In implementing this commitment change, the new commitment will accept joint walkdowns performed by only Engineering and Operations in high radiation areas, high heat zones, confined spaces or areas where other significant hazards are present. This change will enhance personnel safety and still maintain the ownership and joint walkdown intent of the commitment.
