

Request for Additional Information Regarding
Generic Letter 87-09 (TAC #77535)

In a letter dated August 9, 1990, ⁽¹⁾ Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) submitted to the NRC a request for a license amendment change to the Millstone Unit No. 2 Technical Specifications consistent with the guidance provided by Generic Letter 87-09. In the course of the NRC Staff's review, a request for additional information was issued to NNECO by letter dated November 8, 1990. ⁽²⁾ This letter requested a schedule to respond to the additional questions within 15 days after receipt by NNECO. Per discussions with the Millstone Unit No. 2 NRC Project Manager, NNECO hereby commits to respond to the Staff's November 8, 1990 letter by January 15, 1991.
