Dear Sir:

By letter dated August 29, 1990, we submitted the performance data for our fitness-for-duty program for the period January 1990 through June 1990 as required by 10CFR26.71(d). A subsequent review of the submitted performance data forms and the associated reports covering the entry of raw data into our computerized data system revealed that several data entry errors were made while entering fitness-for-duty test results into the system. These errors were confined to the recording of the reason for the fitness-for-duty test, i.e., random, for cause, follow-up, etc. There were no errors in the entry of test results into the system. These errors have been corrected and are indicated on the attached revised performance data sheets by bars in the right hand margin.


